

Tell City Schweizer Fest 2011

Exhibitor Market Rules

The Schweizer Fest Market Place will be held on Wednesday, Thurs, Friday, and Saturday, August 10 – 13, 2011 in the City Hall Park on Main Street. Daily hours of operation for both street and non-street spaces will be from 9.00 am-12 midnights. You may work any of these hours. Most traffic to the event happens from 3 pm to 10 pm. The highest amount of traffic in the Market Place is on Friday and Saturday. You may choose to set up on those days only. There isn't any food vendors open during the lunch hours except on Saturday.

The Market consists of street spaces that are approximately 30' wide and non-street spaces that are approximately 12' wide. A street space must be reserved for four days for a \$100.00 fee. A non-street space must be reserved for 4 days for a total fee of \$50.00. You must provide your own tables, chairs, tents, and extension cords. All booths MUST have a fire extinguisher per state law.

Reservations will be made depending on earliest postmarked applications and availability of spaces. A deposit of 50% is required to reserve space. **Space will not be held without a deposit**

The following additional restrictions will apply – Failure to comply may lead to dismissal.

1. No vehicles or trailers will be allowed on the non-street spaces.
2. A NO SMOKING sign must be posted and a working fire extinguisher must be located in plain sight in every exhibitor booth. **Smoking is prohibited in City Hall Park**
3. You will be allowed to use only one receptacle and 500 watts per space. Extension cords across sidewalks must be taped down to the pavement with duct tape. Only UL listed heavy-duty exterior/outdoor extension cords may be used. Electricity will not be available to RV's with air conditioners. No generators will be allowed. This is strictly enforced.
4. No obscene materials or objects deemed dangerous for children to handle. No items that shoot projectiles if projectiles are provided. (Examples: air guns, etc.)
5. Other restricted items are as follows: Items that emit foul or obscene odors, all types of fireworks, pops, firecrackers and silly string. No printed items with obscene words or pictures.
6. Any knives may not be sold to someone under 18 unless parents are present at booth.
7. Any other restrictions that are deemed necessary by the Schweizer Fest Committee/Market.
8. Although security will be provided during the festival evening hours, neither the Tell City Schweizer Fest Committee, nor other Agent/Representative of the committee is to be held responsible for any injury, loss or damage to persons, exhibits, or materials. There will be a night watchman at the park when the festival is not in operation. The Tell City Police does provide random patrols.
9. Sales are limited to individual booths. Roaming the park with merchandise is not allowed unless prior arrangements are made with the committee. There is an additional \$50.00 fee required for limited permission. This is strictly enforced.

By order of the State of Indiana Fire Marshall

All booths must have a **No Smoking** sign posted and have a **Fire Extinguisher** on hand in plain view.

All booths must only use *UL Listed Outdoor/Exterior extension cords*. Small household extension cords are not allowed.

Failure to comply with the above rules will result in your removal from the Exhibitor Market and loss of any fees paid.
